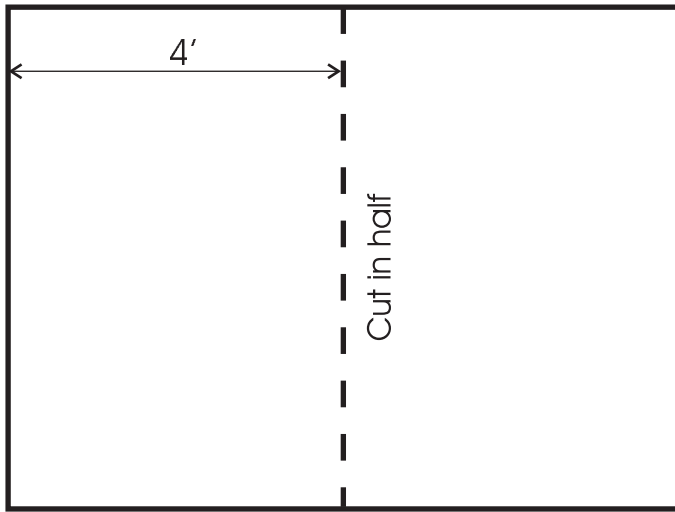
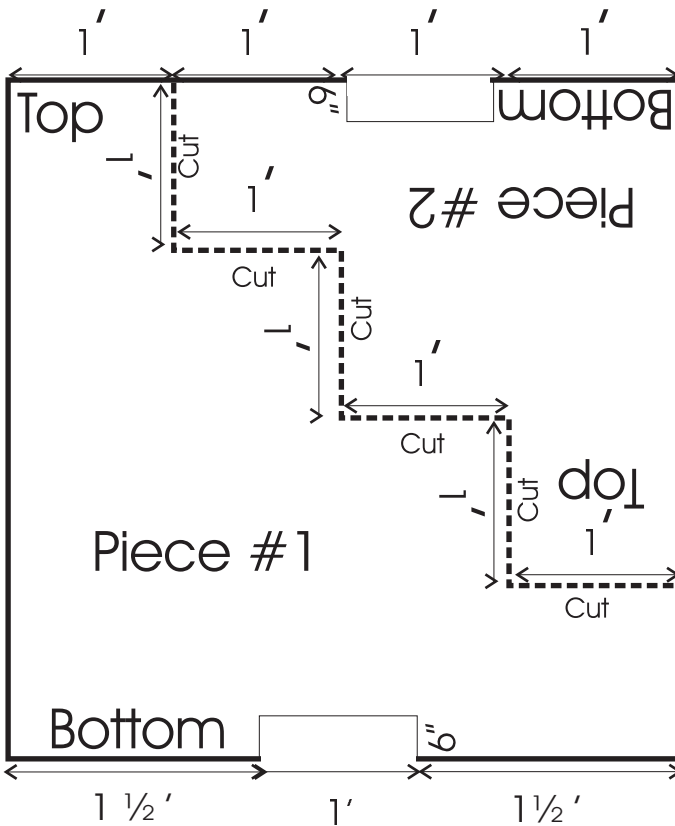


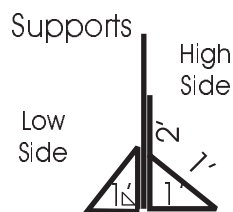
Firearms Training Obstacle Construction



4' X 8' X 3/4 " plywood



4' X 4' X 3/4 " plywood



Each piece of 4 X 8 plywood yields 4 obstacles

2 large

1 - steps right

1 - steps left

2 small

1 - steps right

1 - steps left

1. Cut 1 piece of 4 X 8 3/4 " plywood into 2 4 X 4 halves (to make 4 obstacles)

For each 4 X 4 piece of plywood, you will make two variable obstacles;

1 large (4 steps) and

1 small (3 steps)

2. Cut steps 12" in and 12" down

3. On the large obstacle, cut an opening 6" high and 12" wide on the bottom edge 1 1/2 ' from either side (distances are equal)

4. On the small obstacle, cut an opening 6" high and 12" wide on the bottom edge 1 ' from either side (distances are equal)

5. Sand all edges to avoid splinters

6. Brace each obstacle in the front on one side and the rear on the other using 2 X 4's
 - a. make a 2'X1'X1' triangle on the high side
 - b. make a 1'X1'X1' triangle on the low side

7. Affix the supports to the obstacles using bolts and wing nuts for easy disassembly. Place the wing nuts on the down-range side so they do not hinder shooter.
